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In front of you there are a range of coloured pieces – each colour represents a type of building or spaces that you would find where you live. Look at the questions below and on the next sheet and refer to the planning game key. Start to plan on your map how you think the Olympic Legacy Park should be designed and create your very own Masterplan.

Have a think about the kind of people that will visit the Olympic site during the Olympic Games and once the Games are over. How can this site be transformed to create a lasting Legacy? How will the buildings and sports venues be transformed for public use? What will happen to the Olympic Village? Will more homes and public services need to be built and integrated? How will this area be designed to create a safe and secure environment without becoming a closed off community?

What types of activities go on here? – Schools? Universities? Colleges?

Offices? Factories?

Who studies and works here?

What do these buildings look like?

## **Shops – the blue shape**

Which shops do you need?

What kind of shops do you like?

Are shops important in a community?

## **Community buildings – the yellow shape**

What makes a community?

Who lives in your community?

What does the community need buildings for? What goes on here?
