I am an Architect and my job is to design buildings. Using the same 5 step process you will follow I visit the site and then have to be very creative making models and drawings of my ideas. You will need think about the size of each venue; what they will be used for; look like and are made of. Just like you I have to present my ideas for approval and then go on to produce very detailed drawings so that builders can construct my ideas.



I am a Politician. I want my area and its people to benefit from the new sporting and cultural facilities developed as part of your 2012 Games and I want new jobs to be created. I want to raise the profile of my village, town or city and to host visitors from all over the world. I also want the voters to keep me in power.




I am an Engineer. My job involves working closely with the architect to find ways of making the designs stand up. I can help by letting you know which materials will be strong enough for the job and how to join materials together. From your survey I can also find out if there are any particular problems with the site such as soft ground which would affect the design and help you think about how the weather will affect the materials and how they will last over time.



I am a Producer. My job involves planning sporting and cultural events, festivals, ceremonies, conferences and even parties. You will need to come up with a great idea for your event before you develop your plans further. Our role is also about making sure that people want to attend the event and that they have a great experience when they are there.



I am a Planner. My job involves making decisions about how land is used and places are designed and developed. You will need to think about where your Games will take place - is there a good site near you? How will people get there and what facilities will be needed? Our role is to help create places that people want to live and work in.



I am a local Resident. I live near to the proposed 2012 Games site. As residents or people who work here or will be using the facilities in the future it is important that we are consulted on what might be happening. I know a lot about the history of the area and I want to reduce the amount of traffic in our neighbourhood. I want to tell your design team and help them come up with solutions.



I own the site and decide what is going to happen on it. With a project as large as the 2012 Games I am the local Councils and Government. I sometimes let a developer rent the land who has the money to make the project happen. You will need to listen to what the local needs are and have your own ideas. You will also commission the Architect to design the venues for your site.



I am a Surveyor. My job involves finding out things about the site. As well as measuring the site you will need to find out if the land drains well or could it flood? Other things about people are also really useful such as is there an existing transport route (road or rail) we can use in our project and is there housing nearby?
